## For all visits regardless of the time of day

For all visits with your client please check in and out by sending a text to the CARDS phone **07715082428**.

Text 'In' on arrival then 'Out' once you have left.

All text messages regarding check ins and outs, as well as confirmation of future visits should go to the CARDS phone number (regardless of the time of day).

We will be aware of your visit, however, going forward, we will no longer be replying with a message in response to these texts.

Please communicate the details of your next visit via text and include:

- Date
- · Time
- Location

You do not need to include you or your client's name in these texts.
